Biography

Blade Wynne was born in 1980, in Providence, Rhode Island. He attended Pratt Institute and was awarded his BFA in painting in 2002. During his time at Pratt Institute he received a travel grant to study drawing and painting abroad in Tuscany in 2001. He received his MFA in painting from Rhode Island School of Design in 2008 where he received the "Award of Excellence". His work has been exhibited in New York, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Providence, Philadelphia and Chicago. His most recent exhibitions of work include a solo show at Vox Populi in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, a two person show at Tompkins Projects in Brooklyn, New York, as well as a solo show at The Virginia Museum of Contemporary Art in Virginia Beach.
